



St. Mary 3on3 Slammin' Basketball Tourney

The Delaware St. Mary Athletic Association (SMAA) is sponsoring the 5th annual 3on3 summer Basketball Tournament. This year's tournament will be held the weekend of July 16-17 and possibly the 18th. It is open to all boys and girls entering grades 3-9 at the start of the 2010-2011 school year. Players may be enrolled in any Ohio approved public, private or "home" school system.

- There is a \$50 entry fee per team. Registration is first come, first serve. A charge of \$70 per team may be charged after June 27, 2010.
- Registration forms should be mailed to Mary Hughes, 209 Leawood Drive Delaware, Ohio 43015. Make checks payable to St. Mary Athletic Association (SMAA).
- Brackets/Divisions are divided by grade and gender, dependent upon amount of entries.
- Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 3 games. Last year teams played 4-6 games. The number of games is based upon the number of teams entered into each grade's Division. A Division may consist of more than 1 grade, while attempting to keep it to one grade.
- Each team may have no more than 4 players and should designate a Captain who will receive schedules, rules, and other tournament information.
- Individual trophies will be awarded to winners of each Division.
- All games are played at Delaware St. Mary gym located at 82 E. Williams Street. Parking is behind the church off of Henry Street. Games may start as early as 4pm on Friday and continue through midnight and/or 8am –midnight Saturday, and/or Sunday, 1:30-midnight (Sundays are not normally used for games).
- It is fully expected that all players, coaches, and spectators demonstrate the ideals of fair play and sportsmanship encouraged by the Catholic Diocese of Columbus and the OHSAA. In an effort to keep your tournament "about the kids", the SMAA Tournament staff and all officials reserve the right to penalize coaches and/or players who are not demonstrating these ideals. Unlike some Gus Macker style tournaments, we have at least 1 volunteer official and 2 for older ages. A team's continued play could hinge on the actions of their players and spectators.
- A daily admission fee is charged for all spectators, excluding the players.
- On Saturday morning (8-11:30ish), there is a Pancake Breakfast in our Commons and grilling is done throughout the tournament.
