Budget Review – Chris Hucek

- Basketball-All Fees for basketball are in, checking account balance \$9,146
- Received a donation from the County Engineer's Office for \$150.00

Basketball - Jim or Tom

- Status – Girls and Boys Records-Most teams are doing well good number of wins on the St. Mary side-Go Saints!!!!
- Volunteer Program – Feb 20 (8:30 start 4 Boys games 7th grade?? and 3 Girls games @ 12:50), 21 (1:30 start and last game at 3:40 --- 7th grade boys?), 27, 28 probably... We need a scorer for 12:45-5 or so Sunday, Feb 21st...-Andy will work on obtaining volunteers
- Tournaments start Feb 20th...6th through 8th grade...Team draws Feb 16th.
- St. Mary Tourney, Mar 5-6 & 12 & 13 - 3 teams (6th B, 7-8B, 8G)Return 2 checks; Move practices to City Gyms – Jim-SMAA agreed to send a teams for 8th grade boys and girls,
- 4th & 5th Grade Tournaments (3/1-3-14). We have 3 teams interested (Two 4th Grade Girls and one 4th Boys). What will we support @ \$200 each team...Some coaches have suggested the players/parents pay part (\$10ish)?? Discuss and decided, that SMAA voted to send two teams with athletics paying registration fees.
- Banquet – March 21, Jim McCloud suggested we change the venue to the banquet to another location, such as Donatoes, and charge a fee, most members felt the banquet should stay at St. Mary and look at a different format such as a pot luck similar to the football banquet
