THEOLOGY OF THE BODY: FR. FERGUSON ANSWERS OUR YOUTH "WHY DO PEOPLE HAVE KIDS

"WHY DO PEOPLE HAVE KIDS IF THEY AREN'T MARRIED YET?"

Yeah, it's really best to have children in the context of a healthy marriage. And it's not because there's some "rule" you have to follow. It just makes sense. A wedding (that's a sacrament! a "contact point" with God!) allows a man and a woman publicly to say that they each commit their whole lives to the other... totally! And that sacrament makes "visible" the kind of love God is: total, faithful, free, and fruitful. And THEN, when the bride and groom have sex after the wedding, it "seals" their commitment. Their bodies literally say the same thing their lips said at the wedding: "Honey, I give myself TOTALLY to you!" And any children that may come from their sexual union are a "fruit" of that total commitment of love. Now, why is it that some couples only "live together" and have sex - and kids - without ever getting married first? There can be lots of reasons. Maybe they just don't understand the beauty and logic of getting married first. Maybe sometimes they felt "pressured" by various circumstances to do so. We don't want to say that they are "bad people" because of it, but we do need to say that it definitely makes more sense to get married first and THEN have sex and kids. If it gets tempting for you as you get older to want to have sex with someone without marrying them, talk to God honestly about those desires. Desire for sexual union is not a bad thing (it's actually designed by God to be a wonderful thing!), but like any other desires you have, you have to direct it in a healthy way for it to have the true meaning it's meant to have.

SUNDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's readings set a high bar for us Christian stewards, reminding us that a stewardship way of life is meant to be a challenging way of life.

In the second reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews, we are told to live as Christ lived. And how did Christ live? "For the sake of the joy that lay before Him He endured the cross." If we are tempted to complain about the sufferings we must endure in living as Christ's disciples, we are told, "In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood." In other words, "If you're not bleeding, what are you complaining about?" That is quite a high bar!

The Gospel reading from Luke continues this challenging theme. Our Lord tells His disciples "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing." A couple of verses later Jesus adds, "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division."

Jesus' life on this earth and the message He brought were not meant to simply make us feel good. In fact, His words can make us downright uncomfortable at times. That's because His Good News (and it is indeed good news!) is meant to change us, to make saints of us.

The stewardship way of life sets a high bar indeed. But deeply embraced, this way of life focused on God and others will make us the saints we are called to be.

CATHOLIC MEN'S LUNCHEON – FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 5 – SPEAKER FATHER JACQUES KIK


