

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Today is Easter! That's right! Meooowwww! We can celebrate! 
