

GROW CLOSER TO CHRIST

THEOLOGY OF THE BODY: FR. FERGUSON ANSWERS OUR YOUTH "WHEN WILL I KNOW I AM READY FOR A RELATIONSHIP?"

I assume by "relationship" you mean "going out on dates" with a person of the opposite sex. Well, one of the biggest reasons to "date" someone is to determine if you're wanting to marry that person in a lifelong commitment. But as a teen, you're likely not going to get married very soon, so it's actually best not to feel pressured to go out on dates exclusively with another person when you're still only 14 or 17. In high school, it's better to get to know others as good friends - of both sexes - in group settings, like going to do fun things together as a group of guys and ladies. This way, you can learn more about the opposite sex in a "safe" way where you don't feel the pressure to pretend like you're already getting ready for marriage. I know there's a lot of pressure in high school to be "dating," but it's OK to push back against that pressure and "take your time" with getting to know the opposite sex in general. When you feel "pressured" to date, especially when you're trying to make sense of the new sexual desires that you're beginning to experience, you can be tempted to let those desires "take over" and start treating the other person as an "object" to "use," and that's not respectful to them - or to you. Take your time in high school to get used to your new desires – with God's help in prayer – in a healthy way and get to know the opposite sex in "safe" ways like group activities. Then, as you get older, you'll be much better able to sense when God might be sending to you a special person whom He might be calling you one day to marry. And then going out on exclusive dates makes more sense.

BRING CHRIST TO THE HOMEBOUND

Are you an Extraordinary Minister of Communion (EMoC) or interested in becoming one? We are in need of compassionate volunteers to bring the Eucharist to our brothers and sisters in nursing homes and private homes who can no longer attend Mass. Volunteers are asked to visit no more than five residents of a nursing home once a week, ideally after the weekend Mass they attend. Visits typically occur on Sundays or Saturday evenings, though some flexibility is possible.

We also need volunteers to bring Holy Communion to individuals in their private homes. These visits can be arranged for any day of the week, but must take place after the Mass the EMoC attends. Scheduling is flexible – weekly, biweekly, or even monthly – based on what works for both the volunteer and the homebound person. This ministry is a beautiful way to extend the grace of the Eucharist and the love of Christ to those who long to feel connected to their parish family. Your "yes" can make a profound difference.
