## THEOLOGY OF THE BODY: FR. FERGUSON ANSWERS OUR YOUTH

"As I look ahead to High School, the thing that concerns me most about relationships and sexuality is: "How to understand the person of the opposite sex?"

It's definitely great to want to understand other people, including people of the opposite sex. And high school is a great time to begin to understand the opposite sex in healthy and holy ways. And you don't need to "jump into" an exclusive relationship to do so. You can go deeper in learning about persons of the opposite sex by getting involved in good, group activities with them, like the parish youth group, for instance. Also, take opportunities – as groups of friends – to have serious conversations with each other about what's important to each other as young men and young women. You'll start noticing that not only does everyone have their own unique interests and characteristics, but also, as a whole, men share some good general traits that are worth becoming more aware of, as do women, that maybe you'd not noticed before (see the last question below). Getting to know the opposite sex gradually though group activities will set you up for being able to be more sensitive to, and aware of, the interests and needs of whatever person God might eventually send to you later on to consider for marriage.



#### STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

After today's readings, we can't say we have not been warned about the dangers of mixed-up priorities. God's Word is so very clear today on the necessity of putting Him first in all areas of our lives.

We see this in the First Reading from Amos. The Lord has harsh words for those who would take advantage of the poor and whose priorities are not aligned with God's. In the Second Reading from St. Paul's letter to Timothy, Paul gives us the antidote to

the self-centeredness condemned in our First Reading. The antidote is to imitate Christ, "who gave Himself as a ransom for all." Rather than thinking of Himself and how to "get ahead," Christ gave Himself away – completely – for our sake. That is how we are to live.

In our Gospel passage from Luke, the Lord shows us how to bridge the gap between worldly thinking and priorities and eternal thinking and priorities. Jesus tells the parable of the corrupt but clever steward who is about to be fired when the master discovers the steward has been squandering his property. Realizing his imminent unemployed status, the clever steward reaches out to the various debtors of his master to wheel and deal with them, making friends who would look out for him when he became jobless.

What if we put that kind of effort into our own tasks as good stewards of all God's gifts to us? Into our ministries, into the ways we could make more time for prayer as individuals, as couples, as families, and as a parish? What if we got as creative as the "bad steward" in the use of our finances so that we could give more generously to the poor and the advancement of God's kingdom on the earth? That's our lesson and our challenge.

#### FALL LECTURE AT THE JOSEPHINUM SEPTEMBER 29


