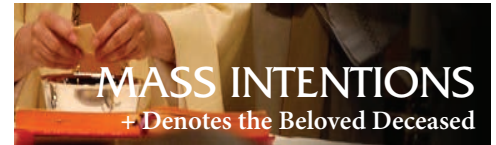

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY CLOTHING DRIVE – JULY 13

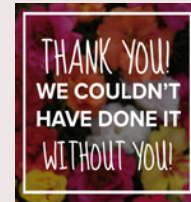
