Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat.

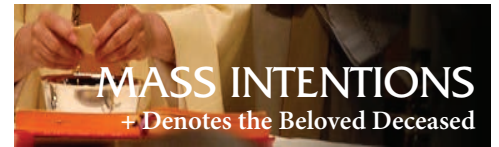

The kinds of tasks that I will need help with are: eating meals, performing morning/nighttime routines (brushing teeth, washing my face, etc), showering, scribing school assignments as needed, and help with personal care throughout the day. Right now, I am especially in need of one or two aids who could work overnight. Lastly, because the money used to pay my aides comes from the state of Ohio, I unfortunately am not allowed to hire international students who don't have work visas. 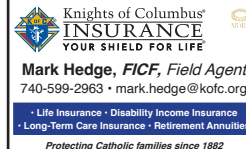
