Volleyball Gym Coordinator - St. Mary Athletics

The Gym Coordinator is responsible for ensuring a smooth and professional environment during Saturday volleyball games. Duties include arriving one hour early to open the facility and setup all essential areas, including bleachers, score table with official documents, scoreboard, game ball, and volleyball net. The coordinator prepares the gym floor and sets up admission and concession tables with adequate stock and change. The coordinator hires and supervises scorekeepers, enforces professional conduct, and has the authority to replace them if needed. Additionally, they support referees, manage potential conflicts involving parents or coaches, and maintain gym cleanliness post-event— including securing equipment and locking all areas. Compensation ranges from \$50.00 to \$75.00 per Saturday during the volleyball season (September 7-October 11). Must have PGC and Background Check complete and follow all Catholic Diocese CYO Rules.

Volleyball Scorekeeper - St. Mary Athletics

Scorekeepers are responsible for running the scoreboard and tracking the official game score. They must remain attentive and professional throughout each game, avoiding phone use while at the score table. This position qualifies for volunteer hours or pays \$10.00 per game and is managed by the Gym Coordinator.

SUNDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's Gospel passage comes as a pat on the back from Heaven for all of us striving to live a stewardship way of life. It reminds us why we live the way we do and why we make the choices we make. Let's face it, if we truly embrace this way of life, there will be people who find our choices — based on serving God and others — downright foolish. But let's see what God thinks. Spoiler

alert: turns out Christian stewards are not the fools!

In this passage, Jesus makes it clear that life is not about "stuff" as He tells the parable of the wealthy businessman who thought he had everything figured out. The man had such an abundance of stuff that he didn't have room to store it all. So, thinking of earthly things and not on what is above, he decided to build a bigger place to store all that stuff. Patting himself on the back, he thought about what good times he would have in the years ahead. But Jesus tells us that day would turn out to be the man's last day on the earth. And he had spent it thinking only of himself. How foolish!

Don't be ashamed of living differently from the people around you. Be confident as you set priorities based on what is above. You are wise in God's eyes, Christian steward. And you will be rich in what matters most.
