#### THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

The Bible is the Word of God. It is a collection of writings which were made centuries ago under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Bible is a great place to learn all about God's love for us and His plan for getting us into Heaven.



As I read the Bible, I've also been noticing that God likes to use the biggest cat of all – the Lion! – to tell us so much about Himself. That's right! 


