## PARISH NEWS



### CHURCH RENOVATIONS HAVE BEGUN

Scaffolding will be set up and moved every few weeks as work progresses. *Mass will continue, though some pews may be unavailable. Also, check the updated Mass, Adoration and Reconciliation times noted in the bulletin.* We appreciate your patience as we aim to complete the project by July 30th. Thank you to our generous parishioners for making this possible!

### NEWS FROM FR. TONER

As Fr. Toner mentioned to us at last weekend's Masses, we have been assigned a new Pastor! His name has not yet been shared at the time of this bulletin printing, but we will be advised soon. We are also getting a PT Parochial Vicar. We will be sharing him with St. Joan of Arc Parish.

We've hired our PT Bookkeeper, Angie Linnane, as well as our Business Manager who will be starting this summer. (Next week's bulletin will have his information.) We have a temporary office administrative assistant, Charlie Griffey to help while Kristin, our Director of Communications/Development is on maternity leave. Please be patient during this staff shortage and transition/training period.


We continue to defer 10% of the weekly offertory for maintenance issues. So far, 12 projects have been completed and others are underway. One of the future projects includes the church HVAC system at \$170,000. Regarding the parish debt, we started the fiscal year in July with a projected \$450,000 deficit. With this year's offertory increase and the decrease in expenses, we are now projecting only a \$250,000 deficit.

We received an ERC check (a Covid relief payment) of \$408,000. In the past, we have had to ask the diocese for a loan to get us through the summer, but it is not necessary this year. As we continue to increase offertory and school enrollments, while managing our expenses, we are well on our way to financial health.

### SUNDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

In today's Gospel, we find the Apostles dejected and discouraged following the death of our Lord. Poor Peter decides to throw in the towel on the whole disciple thing

and go back to his old way of life, declaring, "I'm going fishing." Upon hearing this, the other disciples follow him.

How easy it is for all of us to backslide on changes we have made in our lives, especially when it comes to our spiritual lives. But look how Jesus treats the disciples during their "backslide." He is right there with them in the midst of it, already waiting for them on the shore when they come back from their unsuccessful return to the fishing business (after abandoning their mission as disciples). Our Lord greets them tenderly, gives them some fishing pointers, and then prepares their breakfast. How gracious He is to them!

He is just as gracious today. When we find ourselves "out at sea" — discouraged by our failures or for squandering the gifts God has given us, or simply by a lack of progress in our faith life, Jesus is with us! He is calling to us from the shore to come back to Him without shame or embarrassment, but with hope-filled trust in His steadfast love. He never tires of offering "do-overs" if we just keep returning to Him.

This constant process of turning back to the Lord, of reevaluating our goals and priorities as we aim for Heaven, is the essence of a stewardship way of life. Let us take heart as we continue our journey today, secure in the knowledge that Jesus is beside us every step of the way.

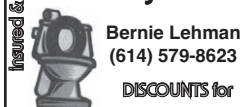

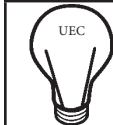

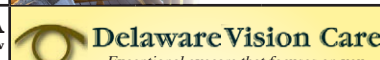
